



Rebuilding Ukraine Association, Inc. (RUAI) is a Florida-based nonprofit organization with 501(c)(3) status. RUAI was established to provide technical assistance, workforce development, and professional education programs that support Ukraine's reconstruction efforts. This includes training in project management, project controls, construction management, infrastructure delivery, and the development of new facilities for producing building materials needed to repair and rebuild communities damaged by the Russian invasion.

Targeted funding will come in the form of contributions, grants, and in-kind donations of goods and services from individuals, corporations, the U.S. Government, international funding agencies, and other charitable organizations.

RUAI's mission is to strengthen Ukraine's institutional and workforce capacity by promoting modern project delivery practices, transparency, accountability, and the efficient management of reconstruction programs and projects.

- During 2022, Rebuilding Ukraine Association Incorporated was focused on forming a nonprofit, acquiring 501(c)3 status, and putting together a team to develop a plan and implement its education mission. www.rebukr.com/team
- In 2023, the education program REUNITE - Rebuilding Ukraine's National Independence Through Education was initiated. www.rebukr.com/project
- In 2024 - 25, RUAI focused on developing its team and core education program, Project Management and Controls Certification Program (PMPC). Additionally, RUAI advocated for its PMPC program in several venues – focusing on transparency, accountability through performance management, and integrated project controls.
- In 2026, under U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Contract W912GB26CA008, RUAI developed and delivered three foundational project management courses from April through June 2026 for Ukraine's State Special Transportation Service through our REUNITE Education Program. Taught in Ukrainian to SSTS executive leadership, senior leaders, and project officers, the curriculum covered internationally recognized project management principles, program delivery methodology, and integrated project controls as practiced by USACE.



A Memorandum of Understanding outlining the **REUNITE** education initiative was produced by several of its participants and signed in Warsaw Poland on February 15th, 2023.

Preamble:

Participants coming together to create comprehensive relationships and strategic collaborative opportunities in Ukraine through successful development and delivery of professional development programs and community outreach activities focusing on professions related to the built environment (designers, builders, government agencies, and the skilled workforce).

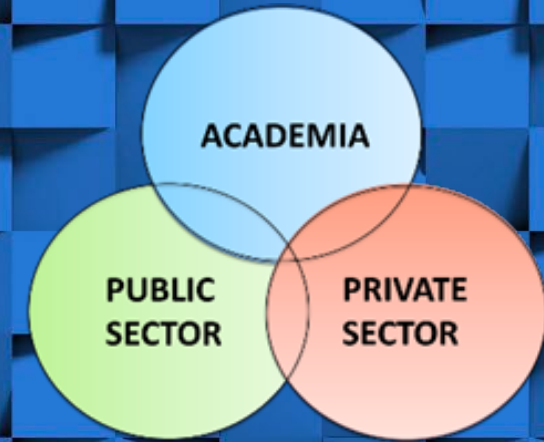

Phased Action Plan Focused on EU Integration

PHASE 1

Months 1-18: "Start Now and Ramp up Gradually"

- Strategic Planning Session
- Visiting Scholars' program (*Strengthen Institutional Capacity*)
- Awareness activities on university partner campuses
- Implement readily available technologies
- Recruit private sector stakeholders
- Formalize credentialing programs
- Rapid deployment of best practices for accelerated reconstruction of critical infrastructure projects
- Provide training on development of grant proposals

 - Recommend the re-establishment of primary businesses
- Coordinate with Ukrainian public sector start of construction
